



## Homework Expectations in Year 1 and 2

Dear Parents,

Each week, the children will have a spelling list to learn which will be tested on a Friday. We will endeavour to make sure that new spelling lists are handed out on a Friday too. Apologies about the first one!

As well as spellings, we will be continuing to use Doodle weekly. Doodle is an online learning platform that adapts to the individual needs of each child. There will be a Maths activity set on a Monday and an English activity set on a Wednesday for the children to complete at home.

Also every child should be reading at home at least 4 times a week with an adult, although daily is best. Please record any time an adult reads with your child in their white Reading Record (There is a Notes page in this book too if you would like to add any questions or queries).

Little and often is the most effective way to help your child improve their reading. As well as helping them with the reading, asking questions about what they have read and what they think might happen next is a vital skill in later reading. If you have any questions regarding how to best help your child with their reading, please do come and speak to me and I will be more than happy to help.
